# **Board of Trustees Meeting**

## January 8, 2019

The January meeting of the Columbia Public Library Board was called to order by President Dan Brutton at 7:05. Those in attendance included Shane Watson, David Jackson, Rodney Schreckenberg, Annette Bland, Dan Brutton, Kathleen Habermehl and Diane Stechmesser.

- 1. Approval of Minutes Motion was made by Rodney Schreckenberg and seconded by David Jackson to approve minutes. Motion passed.
- 2. Public Comment No requests were made to address the Board.
- 3. Treasurer's Report Treasurer Rodney Schreckenberg reviewed the financial report with the Board. He noted that the library was still waiting on revenue from the collection of city real estate taxes. Diane Stechmesser made motion to approve report. Kathleen Habermehl seconded. Motion passed.
- 4. Approval of Current Bills After reviewing current bills, David Jackson made motion to approve payment. Kathleen Habermehl seconded. Motion passed.
- 5. Correspondence Library Director Annette Bland stated she received request for election data under the FOIA. Columbia City Hall took care of the request.

She noted several documented violations and inappropriate actions. Kathleen Habermehl made motion to approve request to send letter. David Jackson seconded. Motion passed.

Mobile Hotspot Policy Revision A request to amend current policy was also made. The change in policy is needed to avoid back to back checkouts. Diane Stechmesser made motion to approve this revision. Shane Watson seconded. Motion passed.
