## November 12, 2019

<u>Board Orientation</u> Library Director Annette Bland reviewed Per Capita requirement "Trustees Fact File Fourth Edition" Chapter 3 Personnel, Chapter 12 Advocacy, Chapter 13 Public Relations and Chapter 14 Trustee Continuing Education. Board was assigned Chapter 14 and Appendices A-G for December meeting.

<u>Patron Issue</u> Columbia Police were contacted after continued disruptive behavior from group of teens. Police spoke to individuals and their parents. They have been banned from library until November 22<sup>nd</sup>.

<u>Volunteer Injury</u> A teen volunteer cut his hand accidently while helping at Library event. 911 was called and he was taken by grandmother to ER. Surgery was required. City Hall was notified. <u>Lynda.com</u> This learning platform has been modified to better protect user's privacy.
