Minimum Wage Increase: Starting in January two employees will receive \$12.00 per hour.

<u>Secretary of State:</u> The yearly General Not-for-Profit report regarding the Memorial Endowment Fund will be submitted tomorrow.

AARP Tax Program: Event is pending. More details in January.

<u>Policy Review:</u> Starting in January, the Board will begin reviewing policies and make needed changes. We will begin with Mission & Roles, Bylaws.

<u>Holiday Closures:</u> Motion was made by Diane Stechmesser that Library would follow Columbia City Hall holiday closure schedule. David Jackson seconded. Motion passed.
